## Contest rules

### Article 1: Theme, Programme

The theme and programme concerned by this contest are proposed by the organizer and made available to the candidates when they register on the website dedicated to the contest:

### Article 2: Conditions for participation

The contest is open to European students enrolled in a school of architecture or any higher education establishment teaching architecture. Candidates can compete individually or in teams (maximum 4 members).

### Article 3: Registration

The students present themselves to the contest using their names, stating their country, the name of their school, the academic program and name of the class, and when relevant, the name of their teacher(s) who accompanied the contest.

When students participate as a team, they identify a team leader and they participate under his/her name. Therefore, only one registration will be allowed per team.

### Registration is confirmed on reception of the registration file which includes:

- Registration form, duly completed
- Rules of "Archizinc Campus" by VMZINC contest signed, dated and preceded by the phrase "Read and approved"
- Rights assignment authorization duly signed, dated, and preceded by the phrase "Read and approved"
- Photocopy of currently valid student card or school certificate
- Photocopy of currently valid ID.

In case of a team registration, each team member must attach a photocopy of his/her student card and ID to the registration file, and must affix his/her signature, preceded by the date and phrase "Read and approved" on the registration file containing the rules and rights assignment authorization.

**When all elements are received, the organisers validate registration and allocate registration numbers to students via email.** If any element is missing, the file will be considered incomplete and the registration will not be validated.

### Article 4: Sending the registration files

### Article 5: Project file

- **Deadline:** Deadline for submitting the project files is **June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2017**.

#### • Presentation :

The project file items will be presented in French or English in digital form. Registration number and project name must appear clearly on each item making up the file.

#### • Items making up the file:

These items consist of:

- **Graphic material :**  
**A0 sheets (3 maximum)**
  - Site plan with identification of site assets and constraints
  - Block plan (1/500)

- Floor plan(s) (1/100 or 1/50) before and after the extension
- Facade elevations (1/100 or 1/50) before and after the extension
- General section (1/100 or 1/50) before and after the extension
- Envelope section 1/20th
- Diagram showing the composition of the partition walls,
- A graphic document demonstrating the construction principle (free form)
- A graphic document demonstrating how the project inserts into its environment before and after the building work (photomontage)
- As many images as are necessary for an overall appreciation of the project.

#### - Material for the environmental section:

##### General

- Site plan with identification of site assets and constraints (access, services, potential nuisances, planted areas, remarkable biodiversity zones, etc.)
- Density increase calculation note: (number of residents in final project - number of residents in initial project) / number of residents in initial project
- Based on the site plan illustration, calculation note of the number of services within a 500-m radius from among a pre-defined list
- tBased on the site plan illustration, calculation note of the number of public transport stops, bicycle spots or carsharing spots available within a 500-m radius

##### Energy

3 bioclimatic cross-sections:

- Heat strategy
- Cooling strategy
- Natural lighting strategy

Using the eco-design tool developed by VMZINC and made available to students free of charge on the Campus Archizinc competition website ([www.campus-archizinc.com](http://www.campus-archizinc.com)), students will also submit the following deliverables:

- Calculation of openings (representing the weight of glazed surface areas relative to opaque surface areas)
- Calculation of Heat Transfer U (W/m<sup>2</sup>K) (representing heat loss per m<sup>2</sup> of heat-lossy surface area)

##### Materials

- Identify the environmental advantages of the chosen materials (sustainability, recyclability, zero maintenance, etc.)  
Using the eco-design tool developed by VMZINC and made available to students free of charge on the Campus Archizinc competition website ([www.campus-archizinc.com](http://www.campus-archizinc.com)), students will also:
- Evaluate the project's embodied energy (representing the embodied energy concerning the materials required to build the project).

##### Water management

- Note and/or cross-section presentation of water management strategy.

##### Biodiversity

The envelope will mainly consist of rolled zinc. However, 15% of the surface will be dedicated to promoting the development of biodiversity on the site (revegetation, creation of wildlife refuges, creation of wetlands, etc.).

The jury will therefore pay special attention to solutions that use rolled zinc to support the development of biodiversity.

#### - Written material

##### Synthesis notebook:

- A horizontal A3 (420x297mm) notebook (10 pages max)
- Presentation sheets of graphic material in reduced format (1/page)
- Architectural synopsis demonstrating the selected building approach

Incompleted files will not be submitted to the jury.

## Contest rules

### • Recommendations

The orientation must be specified on all plans.  
The scale of the drawings must be specified on all documents with drawings.  
Texts and legends must be in French or English.

### • Specifications

### Article 7: Jury selection

#### • Jury deliberations:

The jury will consist of well-known architects, architects teaching architecture, sustainable construction experts, and Umicore Building Products France s.a.s. representatives. The composition of the jury will reflect the international character of the contest.  
Jury decisions are made by majority vote and are sovereign.  
The jury reserves the right to attribute one or more special honors.  
The jury reserves the right to refuse all incomplete files or those that do not meet the requirements of the contest rules. Any breach, even partial, of the obligations stated in the rules may be disqualifying, according to the opinion of the jury. The jury reserves the right to award or not award the prizes if it considers that the projects do not meet the evaluation criteria or that the quality of the projects does not reach the required level.

Incomplete files, files that do not meet the requirements of the rules or are received after the deadline will be excluded from the selection procedure.

#### • Deliberation date:

The jury will deliberate in the months of September 2017.

### Article 8: Evaluation criteria

The evaluation criteria are based on:

- Adequacy of site selection with the programme
- Quality of architecture in the specific area of urban integration
- Enhancement of the use of zinc in the envelope
- The environmental quality of the response
  - Ecology
  - Energy and maintenance
  - Water management
  - Materials
  - Comfort of occupants
  - Transport and societal issues
- The quality of the expression and presentation of the items making up the file

### Article 9: Announcement of prizes

The results will be announced and the prizes will be handed over personally to the individual participants and/or team leaders on the award ceremony evening.

The individual and team winners will be informed by email at the address of the designated representative.

### Article 10: Prizes

#### • Prize money:

VMZINC provides an overall amount of 5,000 € in prize money, leaving it up to jury members to divide this sum fairly among the

winning teams.

If the winner is a team, the prize money will be divided between the team members.

#### • Visibility:

The prizewinners' projects will be presented in a special brochure available in pdf format.

Umicore BPF undertakes to set up communication actions to promote the contest and the winning projects in the trade press on its websites and social media.

### Article 11: Award ceremony

The results will be announced and the prizes will be awarded at the special evening ceremony organized by Umicore BPF in the Paris region in October 2017.

The prizes will be awarded personally to the individual participants and/or team leaders in the presence of the members of the jury. Travel costs for the prizewinner(s) from the town where their establishment is located to the location where the award ceremony will be held, and any hotel expenses for foreign prizewinners on the night of the award ceremony, will be paid for by Umicore Building Products France s.a.s.

### Article 13: Ownership and use of projects and information supplied by participants

The participants undertake to not present a project that has been published or presented publicly, or a product of which they are not the author.

### Article 14: Assignment of rights

The participants certify that they are the legitimate owners of all intellectual property rights, or that they have acquired all intellectual property rights relative to the project they have submitted for this contest.

The participants assign in advance to Umicore Building Products France s.a.s., exclusively and free of charge, all literary or artistic copyrights, i.e.:

- **Reproduction rights:** the right to fix, digitize, publish and reproduce the projects in full or in part, on all printed media and on all types of electronic media, videogram, CD-ROM, DVD or the Internet.
- **Performance rights:** the right to perform, in a private or public setting, distribute or broadcast all or part of the projects, free of charge or for a fee, before all audiences, via all printed media and on all types of electronic media, videogram, CD-ROM, DVD or the Internet.

They will indemnify the organizer and hold it harmless for all damages resulting from third-party recourse, in particular regarding the originality or authorship of the project, without prejudice to damages, if applicable. Non-compliance with this clause will result in the exclusion of the participant or participating team.

**Article 16: Cancellation of contest**

The organizer reserves the right to shorten, extend, postpone, modify or cancel this contest at any time without having to justify the reasons. It undertakes to inform the participants but its responsibility may not be incurred as a result. The organizer alone is qualified to interpret these rules.

**Article 17: Acceptance of rules**

Participation in this contest implies acceptance of all the terms of these rules.

Individual or team participants will affix their signature, preceded by the date and the handwritten phrase "Read and approved" on the registration file that includes these rules.
